The Invitation:

O God make speed to save me, O Lord make haste to help me! Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: As it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen.

Reflection Questions:

Which person of the Trinity is most difficult for you to know, love, or trust?

- Why do you suppose this is the case?
- What comparable names for this person might be helpful? Parent, Mother,
 Brother, Wind, etc.

Give yourself permission to know and seek God in whatever way God is being revealed to you today. Allow yourself to question, to wonder, even to let go of prior understandings of God that might be harmful.

I bow before the Spirit who guides me, in love and adoration.

I bow before thee Sacred Three, the ever One: the Trinity.
